Tamart introduces the Highgate 3-In-1 Interchangeable Seats

Tamart is introducing its new and unique interchangeable seats for the Highgate Chair and Bar Stool at Clerkenwell Design Week 2026. The growing collection from UK brand Tamart includes the Highgate 3-in-1 seats. It is one of the brand's most considered design innovations and now available with three distinct seat options. Each one fitting the same solid FSC hardwood frame, changeable by the user without tools or specialist intervention.

A single frame. Three seats. Endless specification possibilities.

The concept offers a genuine step change for specifiers and their clients. One chair frame can now serve different contexts, refresh its aesthetic over time, or adapt to new interiors without replacing the structure it sits in – making the Highgate 3-in-1 as relevant to hospitality and workspace projects as it is to residential settings.

Clerkenwell Design Week

The three seats of the Highgate 3-in-1

- Padded leather sling seat – The original Highgate seat. Natural vegetable-tanned hide lightly padded and tension-fitted across the frame with contrast stitching. The feel improves with use.
- Padded fabric sling seat – Lightly padded woven canvas textile offering a quieter, more natural character on the same frame.
- Solid oak seat – Precision CNC-machined from the same AA-grade FSC European oak as the frame. Grain-matched and oiled to a continuous finish. Slots cleanly into the frame and sits flush within it.

The leather and fabric sling seats both use Tamart's signature tension-fitting mechanism, which allows comfort and posture to be adjusted and reset by the user. Additional seat inserts are available to order separately, allowing specifiers to offer clients seasonal variation, material choice within a single project, or a straightforward refresh without purchasing new chairs.

Also new at CDW 2026: the solid oak Highgate Chair

The solid oak seat insert will be seen for the first time at Clerkenwell Design Week, marking a new direction for the Highgate collection. The Highgate chairs and bar stools – available in natural ash, black stained ash and natural oak – are among Tamart's strongest performers, and the 3-in-1 system now extends across both the dining chair and the armchair.

The frame is designed for long service life. Made in Europe. FSC 100% and PEFC 100% certified.

Installation at 30-31 Clerkenwell Green

A new installation of Tamart designs will be exhibited alongside the Highgate Collection including the Clore Dining Table and Coffee Table plus the upholstered Clore Chair, Clore Floor Lamp and Central stool.

Latest Projects

Tamart is making ripples in the architectural interior design communities with its designs for wellbeing. This is fuelling a demand by specifiers where transparency in production is essential. Tamart's use of non-toxic and foam free upholstery is one part of their ethical and sustainable production. Some of Tamart's recent projects include Maggie's Cancer care centre in Rhyl, North Wales. Other prestigious projects include: Neil Dusheiko Architects, Rees Architects, Viaduct x Tigg Coll and Kitchen Architecture amongst many others.

Extending Tamart Life

Tamart takes great care to use fine-quality natural or recycled materials and employs sustainable production techniques to enhance the lifespan of each piece of furniture. All Tamart pieces are offered with a return, repair and recycle service.

Tamart is a furniture and design brand founded by the London-based architect Amos Goldreich, honouring the lives and work of his late parents, the modernist architects and polymaths, Tamar de Shalit (1932–2009) and Arthur Goldreich (1928–2011). The brand celebrates the creative and romantic relationship of de Shalit and Goldreich, both key figures in the modernist design scene in Europe, the Middle East and Africa during the 1960s and 1970s, by reimagining and contemporising mid-century pieces designed and specified by them during their careers. Designs are drawn from and inspired by the vast collection of over 10,000 original plans, photographs, documents, and prototypes discovered by Goldreich after his parents' passing. Tamart products are skilfully crafted in sustainable materials and fabricated in the UK and Europe. In addition to care spaces, Tamart's furniture and lighting collections are designed for hospitality and leisure, workplace and domestic environments.
